



## Swim Meet Contract

The following conditions are part of your agreement to be a part of Concord Swim Club

It is the intent of the Concord Swim Club to host three meets (one conference and two invitationals) each year. The meet schedule is included in your forms. Please mark them on your calendar. These meets are fundraisers for the club to help cover the cost of operations throughout the year. They are an important part of our annual budget.

All families must work the meets hosted by Concord Swim Club. These meets are IMX and Heart Smart. Please take note that even if you chose not to enter your swimmer in the meet you are still required to work the meet.

The "meet volunteer" sign up forms will be posted on the board by the girls' locker room. Sign ups will begin one month prior to the start of the upcoming meet. You will have 2 weeks to sign up to volunteer, and then sign ups will close. **THE MEET COMMITTEE WILL ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF SESSIONS EACH FAMILY MUST WORK FOR EACH MEET.** The number of sessions will be emailed to the families and will be posted on the bulletin board

At each meet there will be a registration table for you to "sign in" when you arrive at the pool. This will be where the heat sheets are sold. It is your responsibility to make sure that you have signed in properly as well as putting your arrival time. Please write both your name and your swimmer's name if last names are different. There will also be a "head person" at your station that you should check in with.

If you are not able to work at one or more of the meets it is YOUR responsibility to find someone to work for you or may pay an assessment. You may be assessed a \$25.00 charge per session that is not worked.

**WE DO NOT WANT YOUR MONEY; WE NEED YOUR HELP DURING THE MEETS.**

Anyone working the meet to satisfy a work session must be 14 years old or older. If you have a high school swimmer this does not exclude you from these expectations.
